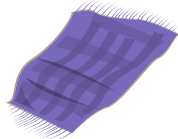
Create greeting cards

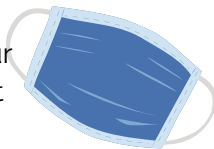


Use Amazon to order our Wish List Items
